



DOGS REGULATIONS

At check-in time, dogs must be accompanied by an adult, equipped with a micro-chip, equipped with a specific health card (or European passport) with up to date vaccinations and valid insurance.

Dogs must always be kept on a leash and, in the case of aggressive dogs, muzzled.

The management and its representatives reserve the right to request that the dog be kept at leash.

The management may revoke access to owners whose dogs due to temperament, character or dangerous, disturbs public safety.

Inside the campsite there are free vending machines biodegradable bags for the collection of excrement with relative basket.

It is mandatory for dog's owners that the disposal of their solid and/or liquid excrement must always take place outside the campsite and removed with a special bag and shovel.

If, accidentally, it occurs inside the campsite, the owner is obliged to remove them with the appropriate tools and sprinkle the area with water.

It is allowed to bring dogs into all public establishments with the exception of the shared toilets.

It is absolutely forbidden to wash dogs inside the accommodation or inside shared toilets.

Dog 's owners must ensure that their dogs does not invade the accommodation or the space of other guests inside the camping.

To noisy dogs, who growl or bark for a while, will not be permitted to stay inside the camping.

Animals are allowed in a limited number, maximum of ONE small size (max 10 kg) per accomodation

It is forbidden to leave dogs alone inside the accommodation, even for a limited time.

Dogs must never be left unattended, but must be constantly supervised.

The management reserves the right to expel, without notice, anyone who does not comply with the dogs regulations.
